**Mrs. Harry Teat  
Dies On Eve Of  
Golden Wedding**

Joy was turned into sorrow last weekend at the home of Mr. and Mrs. Harry Teat. Sunday was to be a big day in that all of the children and relatives were to be home for the couple's 50<sup>th</sup> wedding anniversary. However, it was not to be, as Saturday morning, Mrs. Teat suffered a heart attack and died.

Amy Ann Teat was 69. She had experienced several slight heart attacks through the years and in fact, last Thursday she became ill. The doctor ordered her to bed and remarked that the golden wedding anniversary might have upset her.

However, the doctor said she ought to stay in her bed during the Sunday celebration, although it would be alright to continue with her plans.

Mrs. Teat's daughter, Mrs. Roy Hindman of Cardington, was staying with her mother and early on Saturday morning her mother mentioned that she was feeling ill. Shortly afterwards, she died.

Funeral services were held yesterday afternoon at the Frank E. Hill Funeral Home, with Rev. M.J. Miller officiating. She was a member of the First E. U. B Church. Burial was in Otterbein Cemetery.

Besides Mrs. Hindman, she is survived by two other daughters, Mrs. William Gibbons of Pasadena, Calif, and Mrs. Kenneth Shipman of Sunbury; a son, Edward Teat of Phoenix, Arizona; five grandchildren and two sisters, Mrs. Lulu Harris and Mrs. William Gray.
