Allen Tedrow, Pressman, Dies

Allen Seymour Tedrow, 66, a retired pressman for the Columbus Dispatch, was pronounced dead on arrival Thursday, Jan. 23, at University Hospital, following an apparent heart attack. E resided at 500 Fallis Rd.

A native of Westerville, where he received his education, had been with The Dispatch more than 30 years, prior to retiring in 1956. He also pitched for the Cleveland Indians in 1914.

A member of Clinton Heights Lutheran church and the Quarter Century Club of the Wolfe Industries, he is survived by his wife, Martha; a son, Dallas of Columbus; two daughters, Eileen at home and Mrs. Norma Erion of Pittsburg, Pa.; three sisters, Mrs. Estella Schott of Westerville, Mrs. Nettie Ballard and Mrs. Cora Beaver, both of Columbus, and six grandchildren.
