**Guy Thomas
Services Held
Last Friday**

Funeral services were held Friday, September 5, at the Hill Funeral Home for Guy W. Thomas, 74, of 200 Central Ave., who died Wednesday, September 3 in Grant Hospital. Rev. Richard Ellsworth, pastor of Central College Presbyterian Church officiated. Interment was in Otterbein cemetery.

He is survived by his wife, Olive, daughter Mrs. George (Helen) Hogue, sons Guy d. and John E.; seven grandchildren, all of Westerville, also one brother R. Dean Thomas of Mentor, O.

Mr. Thomas was a member of the Central College Presbyterian Church, Blendon Lodge F. & A.M., Alladin Shrine and Shrine Band, Knight Templar, 32 degree Mason and the local K. of P. Lodge, of which he served as County deputy at one time.

Coming to Westerville in 1920 from Columbus by the insistence of the late Charles Dew, then leader of the Town Band, Guy immediately became a member of the band and played with them until such time as it was disbanded.

He was employed by the American Issue Publishing Co., as a paper cutter, until 1945 when the company became known as the Westerville press Inc. Guy was a faithful employee until his retirement in 1961, serving as foreman of the bindery department.
